Instructions related to Accommodation in the Hotel/Guest House:

1. The accommodation booking link will has been closed on 10th October 2024.
2. For accommodation in the Guest House, the check-out time is 11:00 a.m. (for guests staying in the hotel, kindly check the check-in/ check-out time at the hotel reception). All delegates and participants are required to register for the symposium. The registration fee for the Conference is as follows:

Registration fees will cover the conference kit, book of abstracts, all lunches and Tea/coffee/snacks served during the conference days, conference proceedings publications (to be decided later on), and social dinner (banquets). **The registration will be completed only after successfully paying the registration fees.**

Instructions for Registration of Accompanying Person:

1. The participants registering offline at the Registration counter must pay the full registration fee, i.e., Rs. 3500 for Indian students/Postdocs, Rs. 5500 for Indian Researchers/Scientists, and USD 400 for Foreign participants unless otherwise advised to do so due to technical difficulty (for Foreign participants).
2. The registration fee for each accompanying person (Foreign) is USD 100, and for an accompanying person (Indian) is INR. 1000. This includes full-day entry to the conference venue and social programs, including all conference meals and refreshments.
3. For people staying in the Guest House, the accommodation charges will be collected at the Registration counter and also at the Guest House reception.
4. The breakfast will start at the Guest House at 7:15 a.m. each day of the conference. For participants staying in the VSH Hotel the transport (BUS/Taxi) will begin at 8:45 a.m. (sharp). For participants staying in NABM Guest House, Buses will depart at 8:30 a.m. (sharp).

Instructions for Presentation:

1. The duration of the **Plenary Talk** is 40 minutes (35 min. for lecture + 5 min. for discussion and Question and answer), for **Invited Talk** is 25 minutes (20 min. for lecture + 5 min. for discussion and Question and answer) and for **Contributory Talk** is 15 minutes (10 min. for lecture + 5 min. for discussion and question and answer).
5. The speaker must bring his talk prepared in a flash drive, preferably in PDF format. The laptop (with Windows system) will be available at the conference venue. The speaker must

upload (and check the slides) his talk on the Laptop (available at the venue for presentation purposes) during the Lunch/Tea break on the presentation day.

6. For poster presentation, the participant has to prepare a poster in **A1 page format (23.4 Inch x 33.1 Inch)**. The presenter should be available at his/her poster during the poster session.
